### THE JEWS REJECT THE LIGHT

Jesus turned back to the people He had been teaching and said:

*"I am the light of the world. He who follows Me does not walk in the darkness, but will have the light of life."*

"Thou bearest witness to Thyself, " some Pharisees objected. "Thy witness is not true." But Jesus said:

*"Even if I bear witness to Myself, My witness is true, because I know where I came from and where I go. But you do not know where I came from or where I go.*

*You judge according to the flesh; I judge no one. And even if I do judge, My judgment is true, because I am not alone, but with Me is He who sent Me, the Father.*

*In your law it is written that the witness of two persons is true. It is I who bear witness to Myself, and He who sent Me, the Father, bears witness to Me."*

"Where is Thy Father," they asked contemptuously. Jesus replied:

*"You know neither Me nor My Father. If you knew Me, you would then know My Father also. I go and you will see Me, and in your sin you will die. Where I go you cannot come."*

The Jews were perplexed at this, thinking He was speaking of killing Himself. But Jesus went on and said:

*"You are from below, I am from above. You are of this world, I am not of this world. Therefore, I said to thee that you will die for*

*your sins; for if you do not believe that I am He, you will die in your sin."*

"Who art Thou?" they asked. Jesus said:

*"Why do I speak to you at all. I have many things to speak and to judge concerning you, but He who sent Me is true. The things that I heard from Him, these I speak in the world.*

*When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He, and that of Myself I do nothing. I preach only what the Father has taught Me. He who sent Me is with Me, for He has not left Me alone, because I do always the things that are pleasing to Him."*

To those that believed in Him He continued to say:

*"If you abide in My word, you shall be My disciples, indeed, and you shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free.*

*If God were your Father, you would surely love Me. For from God I came forth and have come; for neither have I come of Myself, but He sent me. Why do you not understand My speech? Because you cannot listen to My word.*

*The father from whom you are is the devil, and the desires of your father it is your will to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and has not stood in the truth because there is no truth in him.*

*If I speak the truth, why do you not believe Me? He who is of God hears the words of God. The reason why you do not hear is that you are not of God."*

### THE CHALLENGE OF FORGIVENESS

Forgiveness is hard! Forgiveness is letting go of the need to make things even, to get revenge, to punish the offender. Ultimately, God is the one who will take care of justice on earth.

God always forgives, but we have to be sorry for what we have done to be able to receive forgiveness. It is the extending grace and mercy given to the other person even if it is not deserved. If our heart is full of bitterness and anger, there is no room for us to receive God's forgiveness.

To forgive takes a big heart and the determination not to let others behavior determine our reaction. It is easy to return evil for evil. Any criminal can do that. It takes character to offer forgiveness.

Nowhere in the Gospels does it say that the people who nailed Jesus to the Cross ever said they were sorry, yet Jesus chose to forgive them. Forgiveness frees us from the hold that anger, bitterness, and the need for revenge have on us. In a sense, if we fail to forgive, people who hurt us, we are not free from them. Perhaps the person who hurt us has died or moved away. Perhaps he or she doesn't even know that she did anything wrong.

However, we can still forgive....

Jesus shared this advice some 2,000 years ago, "*Bless those who curse you.*" Jesus knew the blessing would boomerang back to us. Accept His grace of forgiveness..... Forgive!
